The International Federation of Air Line Pilot's Associations (IFALPA) expresses its strong support for the development of a new Uruguayan carrier, ALAS URUGUAY that restores Uruguay's aerial connectivity within the region and with the rest of the world.

This will allow new jobs to be created for the pilots who have been unemployed since the abrupt closure of PLUNA back in July 2012.
