IFALPA Annual Conference opens today with record attendance

ISTANBUL 28 April: IFALPA's 61st Annual Conference will get underway this morning in Istanbul and will be opened by Turkey's Minister of Transport and Communications, Mr Binali Yildirim.

The Annual Conference is the highlight of the Federation's calendar when the current year's work is reviewed and the programme for the coming year set out. The importance of the Annual Conference to the work of the Federation is reflected in the attendance it attracts and this year is no different, with well over 500 attendees representing 71 Member Associations and other organisations a significant increase on last year's record figures.

The Annual Conference is due to continue until Tuesday 2 May.
