## IFALPA welcomes Senegalese pilots to the Federation

ISTANBUL 1 May: In a signing ceremony this morning the Syndicat des Pilotes de Ligne Senegalais (SPLS) joined the International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Associations (IFALPA).
