Mongolian Airline Pilots join IFALPA

ISTANBUL 1 May: The Mongolian Air Line Pilots' Association joined the International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Associations (IFALPA) in a signing ceremony during this morning's plenary session of the Federation's Annual Conference.
