# Capt. Carlos Limon elected IFALPA President

Dubrovnik 20 March: In the final Plenary Session of the 62nd IFALPA Conference, Capt. Carlos Limon of Mexico was elected to serve as IFALPA President, the 16th since its foundation in 1948. Capt Limon is an A320 pilot with Mexicana and replaces Capt Dennis Dolan who steps down as the Federation's President having served two terms since his 2003 election.

Prior to his elevation to the Presidency, Capt Limon had served for five years as the Federation's Deputy President and before that as a member of the Accident Analysis Committee and Vice Chairman.

Commenting on his election, Capt Limon said "Dennis Dolan leaves behind a pair of shoes that will be difficult to fill and I will work to continue the work of restructuring that he began. To the Federation and the pilots it represents I promise that I will work with commitment and passion toward our goals. I will work hard, I will not let you down".
