63rd IFALPA Conference opens today in Mexico City

MEXICO CITY 18 APRIL: The 63rd Conference of the International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Associations (IFALPA) opens this morning in Mexico City. The Conference marks the 60th anniversary of the Federation's 1948 founding and is hosted by the Asociacion Sindical de Pilotos Aviadores de Mexico which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year.

While final figures are yet to be collated, indications are that the 63rd Conference will have a record attendance with over 600 delegates and observers registered.

The Conference is the governing body of the Federation and reviews the work of IFALPA's 12 standing Committees as well as setting out the work programme for the coming year and will continue until Tuesday 22nd April.
