# IFALPA membership passes 100 with four new members

MEXICO CITY 21 April: In the second plenary session of its 63rd Conference, The International Federation of Airline Pilots' Associations (IFALPA) voted unanimously to accept the airline pilots' associations of Angola, Dominican Republic, Montenegro and Bosnia Herzegovina into Federation Membership. Taking the number of nations represented by the Federation to 101.

Commenting on the elections to membership IFALPA President Capt Carlos Limon said "One of our aims as a Federation is to represent all the professional pilots of the world and passing this milestone shows that we are well on our way to reaching that goal".
