Peru becomes 105th Member of IFALPA

Marrakech 22 March: At this morning's Plenary Session of its 65th Conference The International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Associations (IFALPA) unanimously voted to elect Sindicato de Pilotos de LAN Peru as the 105th member of the Federation.

The Sindicato de Pilotos de LAN Peru represents around half of Peru's 800 active airline pilots who now join the IFALPA family. Commenting on his association's election SPLP President Capt. Manuel Mory said "This is a proud day for us as we join IFALPA especially since we are a newly established union so becoming part of the global voice of pilots will help raise our profile".
