Request for Mutual Assistance for the Aigle Azur Pilot Group

SNPL France ALPA are requesting Mutual Assistance for the Aigle Azur Pilot Group. Their pilots are victims of a social policy that has deteriorated. They are trying to conclude a new Collective Labour Agreement which contains new social rules, however, the company has now terminated all the agreements and is unwilling to negotiate further.

The pilots are calling for the company to renegotiate a Collective Labour Agreement and provide a clear business plan with pilot participation.

The pilots are planning to strike starting 5 May 0001 LT (UTC +2) and concluding 8 May 2359 LT (UTC +2) as well as 14 May 0001 (UTC +2) and concluding 15 May 2359 (UTC +2). The airports affected will be Paris-Orly-Algiers-Lyon-Marseille-Porto-Lisbon-Bamako-Dakar.
