Further Update on Mutual Assistance for VNV members at easyJet based in Amsterdam.

VNV – Dutch Airline Pilots' Association (Dutch ALPA) have provided the following update on the dispute between easyJet and VNV Dutch ALPA members who fly for easyJet based in Amsterdam.

In the Industrial dispute between easyJet and VNV Dutch ALPA, negotiations have continued but remain unsuccessful; therefore, this is notification of possible industrial action for another 30 days; i.e. until 10 August 2016.

VNV hereby requests, through IFALPA, for Mutual Assistance to continue as follows:

Request for Ban on Wet Leasing (Para. 2.4.1.1)

Request for Freeze in Capacity (for carriers inside the Alliance) (I Manual, Para. 2.4.1.3)

Request for Freeze in Capacity (for carriers outside the Alliance) (I Manual, Para. 2.4.1.3)

Request for Denial of Cockpit Crew Contracting (I Manual, Para 2.4.5)

VNV will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments concerning this dispute.
