Dear Colleagues,

Request for Mutual Assistance for VNV members at easyJet based in Amsterdam.

VNV – Dutch Airline Pilots' Association (Dutch ALPA) are requesting Mutual Assistance for their members who fly for easyJet based in Amsterdam.

In spite of negotiations during the past year, the Collective Labour Agreement (CLA) negotiations have reached deadlock. It has been impossible to get an agreement on several things, including, rostering (work and rest times) and retirement issues. There is a substantial difference between the company and VNV positions with regard to the establishment of the first CLA for easyJet pilots based in Amsterdam.

VNV's ultimatum expired on 2 June 2016 and the attitude of the Airline management remains not very cooperative. Since then industrial action including work stoppages are in progress.

Industrial Action, will start on June 12th at 00:00 Dutch local time and end on 11th July at 23:59 Dutch local time.

VNV hereby requests, through IFALPA, for Mutual Assistance as follows:

Request for Ban on Wet Leasing (Para. 2.4.1.1)

Request for Freeze in Capacity (for carriers inside the Alliance) (I Manual, Para. 2.4.1.3)

Request for Freeze in Capacity (for carriers outside the Alliance) (I Manual, Para. 2.4.1.3)

Request for Denial of Cockpit Crew Contracting (I Manual, Para 2.4.5)

VNV will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments concerning this dispute.
