Dear Colleagues,

Update on Mutual Assistance for VNV members at easyJet based in Amsterdam.

VNV – Dutch Airline Pilots' Association (Dutch ALPA) have provided the following update on the dispute between easyJet and VNV Dutch ALPA members who fly for easyJet based in Amsterdam.

In the Industrial dispute between easyJet and VNV Dutch ALPA a resolution has unfortunately not yet been reached. The Amsterdam based easyJet pilots will perform a first work stoppage on June 14th between 06.00 and 14.00 LT Amsterdam. Subsequent work stoppages will be announced on short notice before commencement.

VNV has strong indications that easyJet will crew the affected flights with (management) pilots from other easyJet bases. In the opinion of the VNV lawyer this is illegal in the Netherlands.

VNV hereby requests, through IFALPA, for Mutual Assistance as follows:

Request for Freeze in Capacity (for carriers inside the Alliance) (I Manual, Para. 2.4.1.3)

Request for Freeze in Capacity (for carriers outside the Alliance) (I Manual, Para. 2.4.1.3)

Request for Denial of Cockpit Crew Contracting (I Manual, Para 2.4.5)

VNV will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments concerning this dispute.
