## Request for Mutual Assistance for ASPA de Mexico

Dear Colleagues,

The Mexican Air Line Pilots' Association (ASPA de Mexico), are requesting Mutual Assistance on behalf of **Aeromar** pilots.

Negotiations between **Aeromar MEC** and the airline management on a salary increase agreement started last week under supervision from the Ministry of Labour. Despite the fact that management is showing goodwill towards reaching an agreement, a re-negotiation of the current CLA is being considered by management, arguing that is required in order to have more efficient operations towards future growth of the company.

**Aeromar MEC** informed their members that, in case an agreement is not reached by 14 June, industrial action in form of a strike will start on the following day.

Therefore, **ASPA de Mexico** requests, through IFALPA, the following Mutual Assistance **starting on 15 June at 00:01 LT, until further notice:**

*Ban on Wet Leasing (2.4.1.1)*

*Denial of Training Facilities (2.4.3)*

*Assistance to Pilots Stranded Away from Home Base (2.4.4)*

ASPA de Mexico will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments.
