Update of Mutual Assistance for ASPA de Mexico

Dear Colleagues,

Regarding the dispute between **Aeromar** pilots (represented by ASPA de Mexico) and Aeromar management, ASPA de Mexico have requested that IFALPA **extend** the Mutual Assistance until **18 July, 2017**.

No progress has been made with the company regarding the operative aspects of their contract. In this regard, the pilots' General Assembly voted to keep negotiating with management.

Therefore, **ASPA de Mexico** requests, through IFALPA, to extend the Mutual Assistance **until 18 July, 2017**:

Ban on Wet Leasing (2.4.1.1)

Denial of Training Facilities (2.4.3)

Assistance to Pilots Stranded Away from Home Base (2.4.4)

ASPA de Mexico will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments.
