In the wake of a number of stall on rotation incidents, two of which have led to fatal crashes, Bombardier has released training materials which highlight threat avoidance and mitigation procedures for the CRJ100/200/440 series regional jets and CL600/850 series corporate jets when icing conditions are present.

The materials, which can be found on the Bombardier training website, focus on the serious threat to flight safety posed by even small amounts of wing contamination and stresses the importance of thorough pre-flight inspection and adherence to holdover times following de-ice/anti-ice procedures.
