Request for Mutual Assistance for Norsk Flygerforbund - Norway ALPA

Dear Colleagues,

The Norsk Flygerforbund (NF - Norway ALPA), are requesting Mutual Assistance on behalf of SAS (Scandinavian Airlines System) pilots **based in Norway**.

For the past months, NF has been engaged in negotiations with SAS management in order to renew the Collective Labour Agreement for SAS pilots based in Norway. Negotiations came to a halt last 24 August and thus, both parties agreed to follow a mediation process, starting on 9 September.

As a consequence of this, if the mediation process is not successful, industrial action in form of a strike will be taken by SAS pilots based in Norway, on **11 September** at **00:01 LT**, until further notice.

Therefore, NF - Norway ALPA requests, through IFALPA, the following Mutual Assistance starting on **11 September** at **00:01 LT**, until further notice:

- Request for Ban on Wet Leasing (2.4.1.1)**
- Request for Freeze in Capacity (2.4.1.3)**
- Request for Recruitment Ban (2.4.2)**
- Request for Denial of Training Facilities (2.4.3)**
- Assistance to Pilots Stranded Away from Home Base (2.4.4)**
- Request for Denial of Cockpit Crew Contracting (2.4.5)**

NF Norway ALPA will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments.
