Launched at the 61st Conference in Istanbul in 2006 and run for the first time in Johannesburg in September of the same year, the IFALPA Safety School (ISS) covers Accident Prevention Advisor and Airport Liaison Representative aspects and marries them with a training module that will give attendees a basic grounding in the structure of the Federation as well as ICAO. Upon completing the course, the new safety volunteer will be equipped with the requisite knowledge and information to step into an external Representative role, both for the Federation and their home Member Association. In addition, attendance at the ISS will also provide the foundation which the Safety volunteer can use to advance to intermediate and advanced training leading to eventual accreditation as either an IFALPA Airport Liaison Representative or Accident Prevention Advisor.

1000-1730 Basic Pilot Volunteer

The Basic Pilot Volunteer (BPV) seminar acquaints the pilot with what is needed to become safety and technical representative, including:

- The IFALPA Technical Structure;
- Introduction to the International Civil Aviation Organisation
- Basic communications; and
- The safety volunteer's responsibilities and functions.

3 November

0900-1230 Accident Prevention Advisor (APA) Part I

Accident Prevention Advisor (APA) seminar equips the volunteer with an elementary knowledge in Systems Approach to Safety, Understanding Human Error and preventing its adverse consequences, Implementing a Safety Culture and introduces the practical application of proactive accident prevention programs, such as FOQA (Flight Data Analysis) and Line Operational Safety Audits (LOSA). Part 1 includes:

- Introduction
- System Safety
- Human Factors

1400-1730 Accident Prevention Advisor (APA) Part 2 - APA in Action

The APA Module will continue with these elements:

- SMS Overview
- Safety Programmes, including Flight Data Analysis (FDA) and Line Operational Safety Audit (LOSA)

- APA Case studies

Capt. Heriberto Salazar-Eguiluz

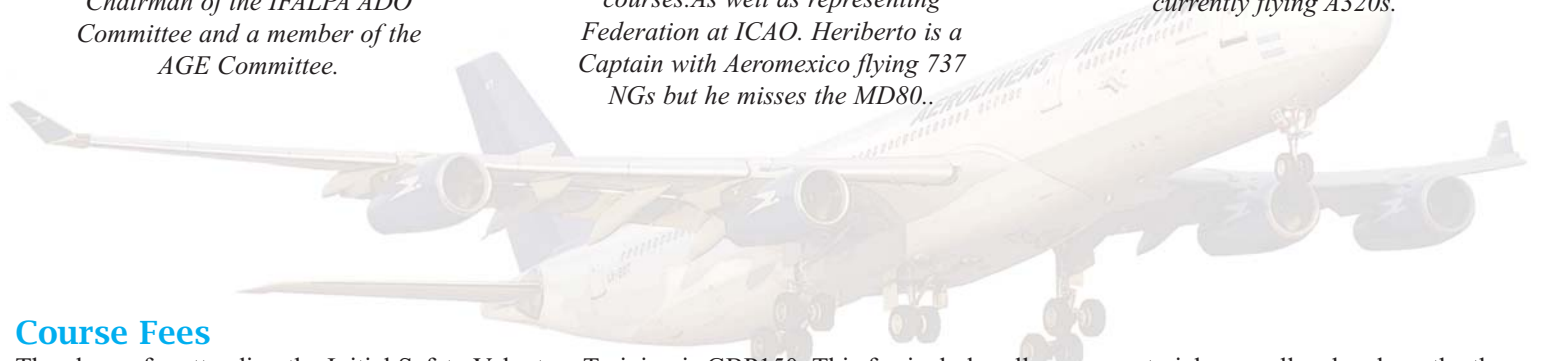
