



Captain Enda Ryan
President of Ryanair Transnational Pilot Group

Captain Enda Ryan is President of the Ryanair Transnational Pilot Group (RTPG) which was formed on St Patricks Day 17 March 2018 at the IFALPA Conference in Luxembourg. He was elected Chairman of the first ever BALPA Ryanair Company Council in January 2018.

Captain Ryan holds an EU FCL Airline Transport Pilot Licence with B737 type rating Instructor and Examiner ratings. He also carries out training and checking in the B737 simulator.

Enda's background is in Police Aviation and he was a member of the first Irish Police Air Support Unit (GASU) which was formed and took delivery of its first Eurocopter AS355N helicopter in 1996 and operated out of Casement Military Aerodrome in Baldonnel, Dublin.

At the BALPA Annual Delegates Conference in November 2018, Captain Ryan was elected to the BALPA National Executive Council. He spends his free time representing his colleagues on both a National level with BALPA and Transnational level with the RTPG.

Enda splits his time between his native home in Ireland and his working domicile in the UK East Midlands.
