Following our previous Requests for Mutual Assistance (21 October and 3 December 2020), we have just been informed by ASPA de Mexico that despite negotiations with Aeroméxico Group have been extended until 27 January 2021, and regardless of the significant progress made, the airline management unilaterally and arbitrarily issued a statement requesting the termination of the current Collective Labour Agreement with Aeroméxico and Aeroméxico Connect pilots.
