Captain Al Gaspari is the IFALPA Executive Vice-President of the Professional & Government Affairs and Vice-Chairman of the United Airlines, Alliance & Scope Oversight Committee (ALPA) at United Airlines. He has 30 years of professional pilot experience having flown for four airlines and former Chairman of the Associations of Star Alliance Pilots (ASAP).

Currently he is flying for United Airlines as Captain on the Boeing 757 & 767 based in Los Angeles, California, USA. Gaspari served as elected Vice-Chairman of ALPA Council 57 (Los Angeles) for a term of three years. Concurrently, he was a member of the United Airlines Master Executive Council and MEC Sub-Committee Chairman. In addition to these leadership positions, he has served as Grievance Committee Chairman (LAX), Local Scheduling Committee, and ALPA Int'l Central Air Safety Committee/Air Safety Committee (America West Airlines).
