

## **Captain (Ret.) Ted Murphy**

Ted Murphy started flying commercially in 1967 and retired in his 65<sup>th</sup> year in 2013. He flew for Aer Lingus for 37 years but also, when on special leave from Aer Lingus, flew for different periods with Gulf Air, Transavia and Air Lanka. He also spent 3 years as a senior official in ICAO based in Montreal. Having retired from Aer Lingus, He was appointed as Flight Ops Manager with JetMagic in Cork in Ireland and eventually finished his 46 years piloting with Jet2 in the UK.
