

Captain Kevin Judkins

Captain Kevin Judkins was born in the UK and raised in Canada. In 1990, after earning a degree in Economics, he attended the British Airways cadet pilot training program at the Oxford Aviation Academy. Upon completion of the OAA program, Captain Judkins faced a work shortage resulting from the first Gulf War and enrolled in the Royal Canadian Air Force where he would serve for the next four years.

In 1995 he was recruited by British Airways to fly their 737. He upgraded to co-pilot of the 777 in 2000 and has been Captain of the 777 since 2013.

Active in international pilot affairs since 2006 when he became a Union Representative for BALPA Kevin served as Vice-Chair of the British Airways Company Council (BACC) between 2006-2012 and Chairman between 2012-16. He has served the chair of the OCCC between 2018-2021.
