Cancellation of Mutual Assistance Aeropers - Swiss ALPA

Dear Colleagues,

IFALPA has just been informed that, after two days of intense negotiations, Aeropers Swiss ALPA has reached an agreement with SWISS International Air Lines. The agreement was signed at 05:30 am on the second day, after approximately 20 hours of non-stop negotiations.

This new agreement has been accepted by AEROPERS' Board and gives pilots better roster stability and an improvement in work-life balance. The financial package as accepted, includes partial increase in compensation for inflation, and an additional increase in the form of a variable salary structure.

Therefore, AEROPERS requests IFALPA to cancel the Mutual Assistance Request **23PGA010**.

The pilots of SWISS International Air Lines would like to thank their international colleagues for their support and all the letters received during these past days.
